Activity: Role-play

Characters: Narrator, Surya, his friend Chandran, Surya's father

Narrator: Little Surya is a very smart and hard-working boy. His father, a farmer, has toiled hard in the fields and has recently produced a rich harvest. Seeing this Surya is also inspired and has decided to follow his father's footsteps. He has come up with a bright idea and is sharing his thoughts with his friend.

Surya: Chandran! I will be taking up farming in a small corner, in the courtyard of our house. Would you like to join me?

Chandran: Why not! The idea seems fascinating. It's the best way to spend our summer vacation. What are we supposed to do?

Surya: We have to get up early every morning, till the soil, sow wheat seeds and water them every day. That's all. I want to surprise my father with my farming skills. So let us get ready. We will be starting tomorrow morning.
