Concept-Value Connection

Activity: Role-Play

Characters: Boy, Stone cutter 1, Stone cutter 2 and Stone cutter 3

Narrator: A large number of stonecutters were working at a temple construction site. A little boy who happened to pass by the site was curious to know what the workers were doing. He approached a stone cutter.

Boy: Uncle, what are you doing?

Narrator: The boy thought that the stone cutter was unwelcoming, proud and ambitious. He moved ahead and saw a stone cutter engaged in his work joyfully. He looked up at the boy and smiled. The boy felt welcomed and was surprised by the stone cutter's joyful attitude.

Boy: What are you doing sir?

Stone cutter 3: (with a smiling face) I am cutting these stones to perfection as we are building a magnificent temple for the Lord.
